

The Youth Orchestra is a Queens-based youth orchestra since 1996, and has been a 501 (c) (3) organization since 2002. Our mission is to provide orchestra training and performing opportunities for musical students age 10 – 18, with a unique repertory that includes Classical, Popular, Jazz, Broadway, Film, and Asian music. The orchestra premieres and commissions works by American and Asian composers and has organized eleven summer concert tours to Asia, Europe and the East Coasts for global cultural experiences.

New members are recruited through auditions in September and January. Weekly rehearsals take place at Middle School 158 in Bayside, New York from September to June. Our teaching faculty members are: Chijen Christopher Chung, music director and string instructor, Chi-Ching Grace Lin for percussion, Lovell Park Chang for wind and brass, and Tony Huang for strings. The orchestra presents two formal concerts annually: one Holiday Concert, free for the community during the holiday season in Queens; and an Annual Concert at Lincoln Center in the spring. The Orchestra also serves the Queens community by performing concerts at senior centers, community centers, and nursing homes.

During the 2017-18 season, the orchestra performed a Christmas Concert at Silvercrest Center for Nursing and Rehabilitation on December 10th and a Holiday Concert 2017 at Cardozo High School in Bayside, Queens on December 17th, and Student and Faculty Recital at Taiwan Center in Flushing onMarch 31st. Additional concerts are the Annual Concert 2018 at the Taiwan Center Concert in Flushing on May 19th, and Alice Tully Hall, Lincoln Center on June 9th. This summer, the orchestra will visit Taiwan and Japan for concerts and sightseeing, as well as cultural exchange with their counterparts in Asia.



A native of Kaohsiung, Taiwan, Mr. Chung began his musical studies in piano, violin and cello at the ages of five and nine. Following a successful musical career in high school, he attended the National Taiwan Normal University where he majored in cello, minored in piano and was awarded the Certificate of Music Education.

Upon moving to the United States, Mr. Chung studied under the tutelage of cellist Peter Wiley (of Guarneri String Quartet), at Conservatory of Music at Purchase College, SUNY, where he received both his Bachelor's and Master's Degrees in Music Performance.

Mr. Chung's wide professional experience encompasses symphony orchestra and chamber music performances, conducting, teaching, studio recording and administration. He served as Associate Principal Cellist of the Taipei Symphony Orchestra, Principal Cellist of the Yin-Qi Symphony Orchestra & Chorus, and the Yin-Qi Chamber Orchestra in Taiwan. He performed with the Chinese Community Chamber Orchestra at Carnegie Hall, New York

Symphony Orchestra and the Amadeus String Quartet and Piano Trio.

Mr. Chung's teaching positions were at the Guang-Ren High School, Xi-Men Elementary School, and Guan-Du Christian College in Taiwan. He has been serving as the Music Director, cello and piano instructor at the Song of Songs Music School, Eastern School of Music, Amadeus Conservatory of Music, and Melody Time Music Center in the United States.

In 2003, he was the Music Director and featured cellist for the world premiere of an original Chinese-language adaptation of A Streetcar Named Desire at the Hwa-Sun Culture Center in Taipei, Taiwan.



I began to write a series of music that was indicative of my prayer life as a believer in the Christian faith and to ponder what "prayer" itself meant. Prayer has been a very big part of my life as I was brought up in a Korean-American Christian family. Prayer was often what allowed for us to find hope in the midst of stormy seasons, gratitude regardless of the situation and to process our sufferings well. I often found myself praying alone for my family, friends and their families knowing they hoped for a better day as well. While many of my prayers were answered, many were left to hope for from afar.

The concept of "prayer' has been the most straightforward yet peculiar, simple but complicated, and the sweetest but bitter experiences for me. Reverend and Theologian Timothy Keller writes, "Prayer—though it is often draining, even an agony—is in the long term the greatest source of power that is possible." I've found this to be true especially while praying for my parents who work tirelessly to support our family. Their long and intense work hours would take its toll on them both physically and emotionally. As I watched them do their very best to support the family, a series of ill-fated events unfolded which led me to wrestle immensely with God in prayer. It was in these moments that I felt the polar opposite pulls of feeling an overwhelming amount of helplessness while receiving an imperishable hope and fervor that propelled me forward.

The piece is structured around the stages of prayer that I've experienced while praying for my parents. Just as the Psalmist and Job sought an audience with God in their angst filled prayers, I found myself doing the same and wanted to express the urgency that I've felt as if I was knocking at the very gates of heaven. I would then pray for my parents and grieve over their sufferings but finding gratitude for all they have done and who they are. This was then followed by a divine comfort and embrace with the capacity to accept the struggles. I would like to dedicate this work to God and to my beloved parents, and all immigrant parents who work without a day's rest to continually support and love on their children.
